

BEECH LEAF DISEASE



LOOK FOR

UNUSUALLY SMALL LEAVES
DARK STRIPING BETWEEN LEAF VEINS
DISTORTED OR CURLED LEAVES
THINNING CANOPY



IMPACTED PLANTS

All beech trees including Asian and European species



A single beech tree can exhibit several signs of **beech leaf disease**, with some parts of the canopy heavily infected while other portions are healthy.
